**Motion #1:**

- Original motion submitted. (This is not the motion groups vote on, it is only to report what happened at the ASC regarding the motion. SEE THE TABLE BELOW FOR MOTION THAT YOU VOTE ON IN YOUR GROUPS.)
  - Original Motion Verbiage: “Groups will provide money orders or checks for all money brought to area (donations and literature.)”
- GSR, No Matter What Group identified a con – some groups are cash only groups and requested amending the motion, for it may affect groups unfavorably.
- Original Motion was amended by Motion Maker and Motion second. See the table below for the final motion on which your groups should vote.

<b><i>Motion #1 (as amended and agreed to by motion maker and motion 2<sup>nd</sup> .):</i></b>	Motion is to add the following to Area Policy: “It is suggested that groups provide money orders or checks for all money brought to area (donations and literature.)”
<b><i>Motion Maker:</i></b>	Area Chair
<b><i>Second:</i></b>	Area Treasurer
<b><i>Intent:</i></b>	To eliminate having cash on hand. Financial responsibility - Provides receipt to the groups for transactions at area.  It used to be policy, but was removed. 90% of the money used to be in money orders. Now, only 10% of money brought to area is in money orders. This motion is to make money orders and checks the norm for donations and literature purchases.
<b><i>Point of Information:</i></b>	Requestor: GSR; Addicts in Recovery 2 (please confirm – I was interrupted by another GSR at the moment of discussion.) Information Requested: Can GSRs bring personal checks? Information provided: Treasurer stated that yes – personal checks can be provided.
<b><i>Pros:</i></b>	1. Safety of the treasurer - If people become aware that the treasurer is carrying large amounts of cash, they can be a target for robbery. This motion promotes the safety of the treasurer coming and going from ASC and coming and going to the bank. 2. GSR’s have accountability for home group funds given to them and can produce receipts.

<b>Motion #2</b>	To amend policy. To make TCCNA a Bi—annual convention. To take place in October 2019.

<b>Intent:</b>	To allow time for planning of convention, securing location, merchandise and, raising funds for TCCNA X.
<b>Point of Information:</b>	Information Requested: Can we use ASC funds? Information provided: The convention received seed money years ago, and is now a separate corporation. ASC funds are no longer used to support the Convention.
<b>Point of Information:</b>	Information Requested: Are proceeds from the convention donated to area? Information provided: In past years proceeds have been donated to area, but not this year. The convention chair indicated that costs were able to be covered by the proceeds; but there was no donation to the ASC this year.
<b>Pros:</b>	1. The convention loses money on annual conventions and it is a lot of work to be done by the convention committee on an annual basis.
<b>Cons:</b>	1. The ASC should not provide input on policy nor contain any language in the ASC policy regarding the convention subcommittee to limit legal liability. The convention committee is a separate entity.

Admin Report- Admin group has had three meetings since last region. (Two zoom meetings, 1 face to face) Group expressed problems of communication between admin group.

Treasurer Report- Open balance 34,944.80 Closing balance 23,355.67. Prudence reserve 8,000. 10,000 set aside for GSR assembly. Set aside 12,000 for archivist salary. Accounts balanced to the penny.

Bay Area- Hosting "CAR is COOL" event. Ice cream social for the event. Everyone is welcome. (their area did not know the date or the location)

Big Bend- vacant positions area secretary and alt secretary. Working on getting billboards up for NA in the Tallahassee area. Moving helpline over the "grasshopper" system. 9 home groups. 17 meetings.

January 7<sup>th</sup> convention committee is hosting a bon-fire as a fundraiser

First Coast- 23 meetings. All is well. No chair for the area. Elected a policy chair. First coast passed out many flyers for NA (3) events and fundraisers. RCM's homegroup is celebrating 15 years and invited everyone to come out. Asked questions about converting and registering as a 501-c3(non-profit).

Forest- Our area is struggling. We have 32 meetings with only 9 groups. Dave (current RCM) is holding all admin positions for area service. He does not want to do it anymore. The members in his area are not interested in being involved with regional service for area service. Old timers in his area express their concerns that both region and area service are an "unneeded expense".

Orlando-51 groups. 89 meetings. Activities is working on an event for the Orlando area's 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Flyer is on Orlando area website. H & I is going strong. Orange county det. Center commitment finally got filled. Webpage committee has no chair or vice chair. Website will be discontinued in March if chair is not filled per area policy.

Heartland- 62 meetings a week. 43 groups. Missing vice chair, alt secretary, helpline chair and policy chair for area service. Currently working on getting those positions filled. Helpline is struggling. Only 2 members attended last work group. Camping trip is coming up next weekend in Bowling Green. If interested, you can look at the website. Valentines formal prom is coming up in heartland. Come with a date or not. Less than 30 days clean admission is free. PR chair for the area made a PSA called "Parents ask for help" The area contacted spectrum cable service and they agreed to air PSL 300 to 1,000 times over a 3 week period. Finished GSR training ad-hock committee.

Nature Coast- 20 meetings, 5 home groups. H & I is functioning but no chair for the sub committee. No website chair. All five current GSR's will be attending GSR assembly in march.

Palm Coast- 132 meetings, 88 home groups. H and I is bringing meetings into 26 facilities. Gave out 140 basic texts last year. Spiritual retreat is happening this weekend, from facebook it looks to be going well. Palm coast started a 501-c3 work group.

Recovery coast- 16 groups. Our area had issues with the bank account. Vacant positions include ( pretty much everything except area chair and RCM)

Suncoast- 43 groups 68 meetings. 23 h & I meetings. All area positions are filled. NA area was contacted by a OBGYN to request phone numbers of active women in NA to give to struggling women at the doctors office. Suncoast obliged and provided volunteers numbers. Monthly cosmic bowling is every first Friday night at 930. ( I thought that sounded like a nice idea)

Tampa Funcoast- 66 groups, 115 meetings. H and I conducts 53 presentations a month. Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> bonfire, feb 4<sup>th</sup> frca support group, feb 29<sup>th</sup> valentines day dance at embassy suites 630 to midnight, march 2<sup>nd</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> mens retreat. March 23<sup>rd</sup> - 25 womens spiritual retreat. All flyers are located on tampa funcoast website. Treasure Coast- 40 meetings, 31 home groups. H&I brings meetings into 14 facilities. Lee was elected as new convention chair. What happened at our areas last ASC was talked about. Our area is doing well. We have some new people stepping up and people want to be involved. We have 8 people coming to GSR assembly.

AD response to Treasure coast- We had a meeting the Bay area that was a womens meeting. They chose not to be on the meeting list. If a group chooses not to be on a meeting list that is their group's conscious. Many people responded all pretty much expressed the same thing. NA service has the ability to remove a meeting if they are not following traditions, but you cannot force a meeting onto a meeting list. If a group chooses to stay off that is their own decision. RD said " If someone could prove to me how that affects other groups or na as a whole I would love to hear it"
