**Open Forum:**

**Announcements:**

- The ASC Treasurer has requested that money orders are brought to Area in lieu of cash.
- The CAR workshop is scheduled for Sunday, Feb. 18<sup>th</sup> from 1 – 4 pm at St. Mary's (same location where the ASC meets.) GSRs and anyone interested in learning about the CAR is welcome to attend.
  - The CAR is the set of motions that each group in NA is to vote on. The results of the CAR provide the basis of discussion (or part of the agenda) for the World Service Conference (WSC.)
  - The GSR is responsible for coordinating information and participation in the CAR for their respective groups.
  - A trusted servant from the Florida Region will come down to the Area in conjunction with the Palm Coast Area for the learning day.
  - If you have questions, please reach out to Ray or Benji for information and support.
  - The CAR is available online at na.org.
  - It was requested that a copy of the CAR is placed on the treasurecoastarea.com website.

- An attendee at ASC asked if the Area provides literature to H&I? The answer is yes – Books for H&I are made available by ASC per policy.
- The RCM is coordinating with a trusted servant from the Florida Region to provide a presentation on what PR/PI is. The date is tentatively scheduled for March 10, 2018. Details are in the works. Please share this information with your home groups, for the subcommittee will need support.
- The Activities Chair provided verbal notice that he is resigning from the position effective immediately (that day.) He provided recommendation for Michael S. to be nominated as the Activities Chair. The nomination process and qualifications are documented under New Business.
- Michele B. was nominated to be the Area Secretary. The details of the nomination process and qualifications are also documented under New Business.
- After two consecutive absences the group will lose voting participation, and will not be included in quorum. To regain voting participation, and its place in quorum, the group must participate in 2 consecutive ASC meetings. Please refer to ASC policy for more information. “\*” indicates that the home group has been removed from quorum.

### **Old Business:**

- Leigh has been nominated as the TC Convention Subcommittee Chair. His qualifications were distributed to all GSRs via email. GSRs were asked to review Leigh’s qualifications for the position. It was requested by the area Chair to announce that the service position was open in area meetings to allow anyone else that is interested in being the convention chair to be nominated. If others are nominated, the nomination and qualification process will continue. If there are no other nominees, the floor is open to motion for a vote.
  - **Update 1/14/18** – All but one GSR received Leigh’s qualifications via email. The GSR did not recall the qualifications that were provided in the Dec. ASC, when Leigh was nominated.

## **New Business:**

Activities Chair Position - Replacement: (Will be voted on at Feb. ASC)

- With the resignation of the Current Activities Chair, the position is open for nominations.
- The ASC vice-chair opened the floor for nominations and read a description of the position.
- **Mike S.** was nominated for the Activities Chair position. Mike is the current Activities Vice-Chair and his qualifications are as follows:
  - Clean Date: 8/7/15
  - Home Group: Recovery In the Park
  - Service: HNI panel leader – 1 year; GSR – 6 months; Activities Vice-Chair – 8 months.
  - I have strong leadership and organizational skills.
  - I have an NA sponsor who has an NA sponsor
  - I work NA steps and attend NA meetings regularly
  - I have the time and resources required for the position as I have had for the past 8 months.

Secretary Position: (Will be voted on at Feb. ASC)

- **Michele B.** did not meet qualification requirements for the Secretary position when she was nominated in June 2017. She did not have the requisite experience in the Treasure Coast Area ASC, as required by the policy. She was assigned to the Acting Secretary position in July 2017 as a member of an ad-hoc subcommittee to perform the duties of the Secretary, but was not elected to perform the duties.
- Michele B. was re-nominated for the Secretary position. Her qualifications are as follows:
  - Clean date: 8/20/2002
  - Performing duties of the Secretary position since July 2017 and I would like to continue to serve.
  - Service in Montgomery Area and Frederick Area of NA in Maryland
    - GSR for Multiple meetings in both Areas
    - H&I commitments in Montgomery Area
    - Multiple group level service commitments for multiple years.
  - Conduct executive meetings for a multi-billion dollar, international corporation
  - IExtensive experience in creating, managing and distributing meeting minutes. It is part of my everyday duties and responsibilities for work. I collect information and report it in an organized and meaningful manner.
  - Work an NA program.
  - Working knowledge of and live to the best of my ability the principles of the 12 steps/12 traditions/12 concepts.
  - Have an NA sponsor who has an NA sponsor that lives the 12/12/12 of NA

From Open Forum with a motion:

- A member of the Treasure Coast Area of NA expressed concern that the Klean & Krazy group removed a Sunday meeting from the meeting list and that there is a flyer advertising the meeting and the flyer is being read at group announcements. The member asked why the meeting did this.

The Acting Area Secretary indicated that the ASC has no authority over groups and that any concerns with removing the meeting should be discussed with the group at the group's business meeting. The acting area secretary also indicated that groups decide what is announced at their meetings.

The Activities Chair stated that the meeting list is [the ASC's] and that the meeting is to be included on the meeting list. The discussion became fervent and was difficult to follow for documentation purposes.

Many of the assembly were speaking at the same time, some comments were accusatory and some were out of order. Several members of the assembly asked what is going on and why the group did it.

Many alleged that the group didn't want treatment centers at the meeting, which the GSR stated was not correct. Other's also alleged that the group is not following traditions, which many disagreed on. Others alleged that it was a secret meeting, which the GSR stated was not correct because it is being announced and flyers were handed out for the new meeting location.

The GSR noted that none of the members bringing forth allegations were at the group business meeting and did not participate in or have actual knowledge of the group's conscious used in the decision making. The GSR spoke in order during the group's report timeframe and answered the question as to why the group decided to temporarily remove the meeting from the meeting list.

The group's GSR stated that the information being discussed among the ASC members is not accurate and members can learn about the decision of the group. The reasons for the group decision are noted below:

- The meeting is only temporarily off the list. It is not permanent.
- The decision is not about treatment centers as many had alleged. Klean & Krazy currently hosts a meeting at a facility on Wednesday night where treatment centers were explicitly forbidden by the facility. The group's conscious was to work out the issue with the facility instead of forbidding treatment centers. No addicts have been or are turned away.
- There are two other meetings on Sunday night at the same time listed on the meeting list that can be attended by any addict – no addict seeking a meeting on Sunday night will be denied the ability to attend a meeting.
- The action taken was the result of a group conscious at the group's business meeting.
  - The meeting needed a new location to meet because The Place closed, where it had been meeting previously. The temporary outdoor meeting location was an outdoor park and the meeting was in danger of closing because of low meeting attendance.
  - The intent of taking the meeting off of the list is to allow the Klean & Krazy group an opportunity to temporarily limit the number of attendees so they can ensure that they meet the facilities expectations and to establish a rapport with the facility.
  - Other groups had met in this facility before during daytime hours when there was a representative from the facility available on site to manage the facility. This is a new facility for [Klean & Krazy.] The facility has different expectations of the [Klean & Krazy] group compared to other NA groups that had met there in the past.

- [Klean & Krazy] meets at night – there is no facility representative available.
- The [Klean & Krazy] group was provided with a key, and has additional responsibilities and expectations required by the facility for ensuring the facility is opened, closed and maintained per facility expectations before, during and after the NA meeting.
- The group made a decision to ensure that the relationship of the Klean & Krazy group with the facility is satisfactory in the short term to ensure that the facility continues to make the meeting space available to them for the long run.

There was much more discussion and allegations made toward the GSR. Verbal motions were put forth to order the meeting to be listed on the meeting list. The area vice-chair indicated all motions are required to be submitted in writing. The Activities vice-chair wrote a motion and all information pertaining to this item is continued below.

***The GSR of Klean & Krazy requests that all learn about the group’s decision prior to discussions taking place.***

<b><i>Motion #1:</i></b>	All meetings in the Treasure Coast Area are to be listed on the meeting list.
<b><i>Motion Maker:</i></b>	Activities Chair ( <i>Resigned</i> )
<b><i>Second:</i></b>	GSR; No Matter What group
<b><i>Intent:</i></b>	It is a violation of traditions 1, 3 and 5.
<b><i>Point of Information:</i></b>	<p>Requestor: Acting Secretary – Where in the policy do the groups grant the ASC governing authority over groups to force them to be on the meeting list?</p> <p>Response provided: It is not stated in the policy that the ASC has authority to force groups to be on the meeting list.</p> <p>The acting secretary recommended that the motion is ruled out of order, for the ASC is not a governing body and has no authority over the group. Giving the ASC any authority over the group is a reversal of the service structure. The ASC exists only to serve the group.</p> <p>Other’s disagreed and stated that just because the policy did not explicitly state that the ASC has authority to force the group to be on the meeting list, it is not out of order because it does not currently limit the ASC’s authority to do so.</p> <p>The recommendation to rule the motion out of order was not accepted by the Vice-Chair who was acting as chair in the absence of the Chair.</p>
<b><i>Point of Information:</i></b>	<p>Requestors: Acting Secretary and the RCM reached out to the Florida Region and World Services to seek experience related to this motion.</p> <p>Response Provided: Region currently has meetings that are not on a meeting list per the request of the group.</p> <p>World Services stated that there are registered NA meetings that do not appear on any meeting lists anywhere. NA World Services is also aware that there are unregistered meetings that are not members of any Area or Region. NA World</p>

	Services exists to be of service to the group and supports the inverted NA service structure. World Services recognizes the autonomy of any NA group and will honor a group's wish to be removed from the NA.org online meeting search, as well as, the NA meeting search App. NA World Services will continue to honor the group's wishes if this motion is approved.
<b>Point of Information:</b>	Requestor: Alt. RCM – what is the maximum capacity of the room? Can the room capacity limit the number of attendees? Response provided: Maximum capacity is not known.
<b>Pros:</b>	1. Forces the groups to adhere to the traditions. 2. Promotes NA unity.
<b>Cons:</b>	1. The motion violates traditions 2 and 4. Leaders do not govern and each group is autonomous. It is up to that particular meeting to decide if it is on the meeting list or not. ASC has no authority over the group per the service structure. The ASC exists to serve the group. 2. A group's needs will being overruled by the ASC. This is not how the service structure is supposed to function.
<b>Motion Status:</b>	Tabled to groups for vote.
