### Open Forum:

August 2017 Meeting Minutes Approved. (September ASC was cancelled due to Hurricane IRMA.)

### Announcements:

- After two consecutive absences the group will lose voting participation, and will not be included in quorum. To regain voting participation, and its place in quorum, the group must participate in 2 consecutive ASC meetings. Please refer to ASC policy for more information. “\*” indicates that the home group has been removed from quorum.
- Acting Secretary suggested that the executive committee arrives early to ASC to welcome new GSRs, provide guidance to those requesting assistance, and to be available to answer questions.

- An assembly member mentioned that Learning Days had once been implemented, and another indicated that the Learning Days were not successful.
  - Activities Chair suggested that a new Area Service position is created to fulfill this function due to the numerous demands that are already on the ASC Executive Committee and the timing of this service being right before ASC begins.
  - An ASC attendee indicated that greeters make people feel welcome.
  - Another ASC attendee stated that their experience was that the former GSR brought the new GSR to the ASC to show them what to do.
  - Another ASC attendee indicated that we can help each other. Position may not be necessary.
  - Another GSR indicated that members of H&I would not be able to provide this service due to the H&I subcommittee meeting taking place at the same time.
  - The position was referred to as a “help desk” position as not to limit the function to that of greeting people, when they arrived.
- A GSR asked about the ASC’s stance on mailing meeting minutes via a postal carrier. Acting Secretary responded that meeting minutes are emailed in PDF format and posted to the ASC website.
  - The acting secretary suggested a motion to be put forth for the creation of an ad hoc subcommittee to review/update forms used by ASC. The intent is to provide forms that are useful to the ASC in reporting GSR and Subcommittee reports.
    - Forms would be evaluated to ensure that information reported by GSRs and Subcommittee Chairs aligns with reporting guidelines per the ASC policy.
    - Multiple formats for each form would also be considered. (i.e. – data entry formats that can be filled out on a computer or formats that can be printed and filled in by hand writing.)
    - Activities Chair indicated that no motion was needed for the creation of an ad hoc subcommittee.
    - Volunteers for the ad hoc committee were identified during the meeting and exchanged contact information at the conclusion of ASC to further coordinate. The ad hoc committee will coordinate the meeting to achieve the aforementioned. A tentative meeting is set for 2:00 Sunday before the next ASC.
